## *Application for Admission*



Prospective parents are invited to come to our Open Day, held in the Autumn Term, where they will have an opportunity to have a look around the School and meet staff and pupils. Visitors to the School are most welcome at other times by prior arrangement.

Applications are accepted at all times although parents applying in the year preceding entry are asked to submit application(s) by 1st December, wherever possible. A non-refundable registration fee should accompany each application.

Assessments for entry, at all stages, are usually held between November and February each year and offers made in February or early March. However, we are happy to assess children at other times of the year, where appropriate. On acceptance of a place parents are asked to pay a deposit which may be refunded when the pupil leaves School.

If you would like more information, would care to visit the School, or have now decided that you would like your son or daughter to come to Heriot's, please do not hesitate to contact us. We will be pleased to hear from you and to welcome you.

### ASSISTANCE WITH FEES

*The main forms of fee remission are:*

#### The Foundation and James Hardie Bursaries

Awards of full fee remission to the sons and daughters of widows and widowers. Applicable to pupils at all ages (except Nursery), and subject to both residential and financial criteria.

#### Scholarships: *Academic*

One award of half fees on entry to Senior One. Awards of other academic scholarships are made in the form of prizes which do not involve a reduction in fees.

#### Scholarships: *Special Skills*

Application may be made for special skills scholarships in Art, Drama and Music. These are awarded to pupils who have reached a very high standard in these subjects. Further details may be obtained from the Admissions Office. Pupils entering S5 or S6 may also be eligible for an I.T. Scholarship.

#### Bursaries

Governors' and Heriot Appeal Trust Bursaries of up to full fees can be made to the pupils of families demonstrating financial need. Awards may be made to new or current pupils. These awards are intended to help pupils in P6 or above. However, in exceptional circumstances, younger pupils may also be considered.



### Notes

All Scholarships and Bursaries are subject to annual review. All awards are made at the discretion of the Headmaster, George Heriot's Trust and the George Heriot's School Appeal Trust.

Applications should normally be made during the period November to January. However, in exceptional cases, consideration may be given to applications outwith this period.
