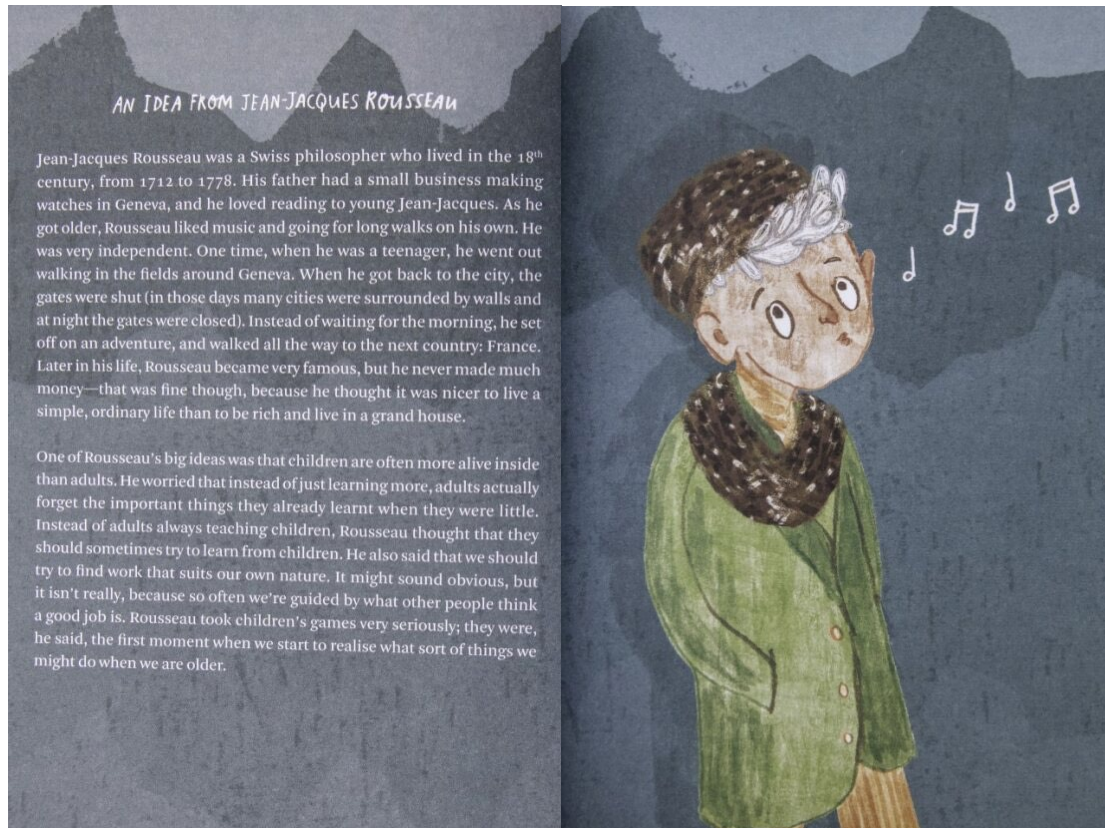


An idea from Jean-Jacques Rousseau
